**Sycamore's trip to Longleat zoo**

Year 5 went on a trip to Longleat on 8<sup>th</sup> of June. It was based on their topic of Madagascar. When they got there the first thing they did was handle animals such as snakes, wallaby's, spiders and millipedes [none of them poisonous]. Then we went to see a few animals in their homes. After that we went to see a dinosaur exhibit with mechanical dinosaurs representing a few scenarios from the cretaceous period giving you a faint idea of what it would be like 65million years ago. After that we had a nutritious lunch preparing us for the rest of the day. After lunch we went to see more animals, the meerkat and parakeet walk through, we also saw some rays and a seahorse.
