Dear Reader

Today is the Second of Advent and when we light our Advent wreath we will be remembering the prophets. People like Isaiah, Jeremiah, Micah, Malachi and others from the Old Testament. Prophets are not simply people who predict the future. They are God's appointed people to tell it how it is in their day and time - uncomfortable people who face up to injustice, discrimination, presumption and bad behaviours and point people back to God and his character of goodness, fairness and covenant love. They call us to repentance and change. I wonder who we would say our prophets of today across the world? I wonder if we might be prophets to our own community, society and in our relationships? This is an Advent theme.
